DESCRIPTION

The inviting nose starts with clean riverbank aromas, then finds yellow plums and kirsch - it sweetens gradually to marzipan, apricot Danish, Dolly Mixtures and dark chocolate. The palate is warming and sweet - lemon curd on scones, Battenberg cake and marshmallows, with an intriguing tingling finish of iced gingerbread, sour apple sweets, lemon peel and menthol. The reduced nose is urbane and lovable - rose Turkish Delight and marmalade cake, becoming gently effervescent (Refreshers, popping candy). The palate now is sweet and fruity (pineapple, mango, passion fruit) with a mixture of light fizz (purple pastilles, Creamola Foam) and warm satisfying spice to finish.

DESCRIPTION

The air was filled with a bouquet of rich decadent aromas, from pineapples and nectarines to charred wood and delicate floral perfumed notes finishing with dark chocolate hazelnut truffles. A wonderful luxurious mouthfeel, plenty of vanilla sweetness and a touch of spice like in cinnamon apple jack pancakes. Diluted; barbecued bourbon bananas using demerara sugar, chopped roasted walnuts, vanilla extract and, of course, plenty of Bourbon. On the palate this was served with thick double cream, making it an all-embracing experience. Eleven years in an ex-bourbon hogshead we transferred this whisky into a virgin oak hogshead with a heavy toast and a medium char.

We imagined sitting in a traditional Spanish courtyard garden, with plants in terracotta pots hanging from whitewashed walls, drinking sparkling sweet cherry lemonade. Nothing sweet on the palate neat, our tongue sizzled when the intense flavour started to overwhelm us searing our cheeks like red hot cinnamon-orange spiced black tea - we all reached for the water jug. Back in the shade of the courtyard garden we were now able to relax with caramelised peach ice cream and salted caramel sauce as well as coconut lime cup-cakes and a Spanish flan made with orange zest and cinnamon.

DESCRIPTION

Things open up with unusual notes of butterbean hummus, apple pie and pear drops. There follows rosewater, lemon meringue pie, vanilla pods and cream soda. A whiff of airfix glue and marker pens with some old photocopier paper thrown in for good measure. Fascinating stuff. Water brings a more classical earthiness along with pink candyfloss, strawberry wine, potpourri, cooking sherry and almond milk. This sweetness continues to the palate with notes of ice cream cola floats, spearmint chewing gum, oreo cookies and battenberg cake. With water the spicier aspects are heightened. Notes of cocoa and bitter chocolate alongside curry leaf, star anise, blackjack chews and brazil nuts.
